UC2IT is part of Ansar Services' long-term strategy to help address current and future career challenges faced by youth living in minority and underserved communities. It provides a well-structured environment in which young men and women are encouraged, supported, and effectively guided as they work to reach their human potential; and become high achieving contributors to their respective professions, communities, and to society.

Our UC2IT® Academy

In 2020, we launched the UC2IT Academy as a virtual, interactive learning environment. We guide youth (ages 14 to 21) through an engaging process of personal growth and enrichment, as part of our Youth Self-Leadership Development (YSLD) program. The Academy provides minority youth with online opportunities to learn more about and receive instruction in areas of emerging technologies. This also helps lead them to new career opportunities. The Academy includes our collaboration with IT organizations, such as the IBM Corporation.

These areas include Artificial Intelligence, Data Science, Cybersecurity, Blockchain, etc. UC2IT students also earn IBM Badges, which provide them with an industry recognized level of learning.

How Parent and Families Benefit

Parents are empowered to be champions and cheerleaders in the educational experiences and success of their children. They learn to provide important encouragement and help to cultivate their children's development of science, technology, and leadership skills.

Preparing for the Future and Success

Students who attend UC2IT develop confidence, competence, and marketable skills through hands on and "minds-on" experiences. They learn about the implementation of emerging technologies across various technical disciplines, which prepares them for future exploration and career opportunities in the Global Innovation and Technology marketplace.
